

HOW TO MAKE A FACE MASK

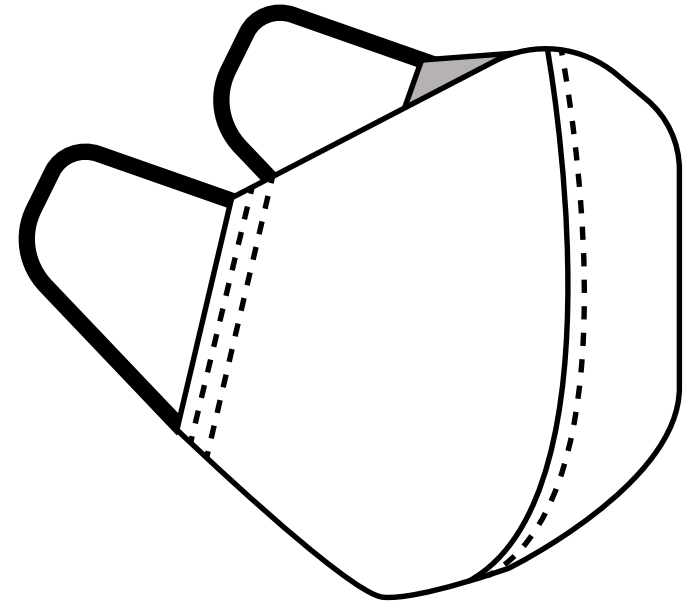
PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING NOTES:
"WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT YOUR HOMEMADE MASKS"

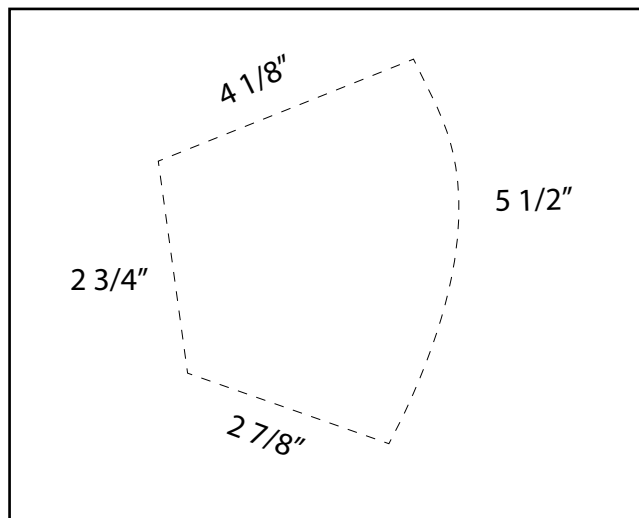
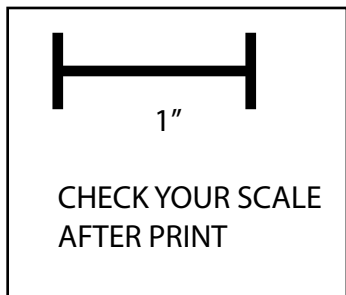
- THIS FITTED FACE MASK PATTERN INCLUDES "FILTER POCKET FLAPS" TO HOLD REMOVEABLE MATERIAL.
- FABRIC USED TO MAKE MASKS SHOULD BE BREATHABLE AND PRE-WASHED.
- WASH THE MASK BETWEEN EACH USE. NEVER REUSE THE REMOVABLE FILTERS.
- THIS REUSABLE MASK IS MOST EFFECTIVE FOR SHORT TERM USE (3 HOUR MAXIMUM).
- ALWAYS PUT ON AND REMOVE THE MASK WITH CLEAN HANDS AND BY THE EAR/HEAD STRAPS.
- THIS HOMEMADE MASK HAS NOT BEEN TESTED OR APPROVED BY ANY HEALTH ORGANIZATIONS AND IS NOT A MEDICAL GRADE MASK.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 0.25 METER OF FABRIC (100% COTTON, MEDIUM TO HEAVY WEIGHT)
- 20" ELASTIC (OR TWILL, RIBBON, BINDING TAPE)
- NOSE WIRE/ ADJUSTABLE METAL WIRE (OPTIONAL) - NOT SHOWN IN VIDEO
- FILTRATION LAYER (OPTIONAL)

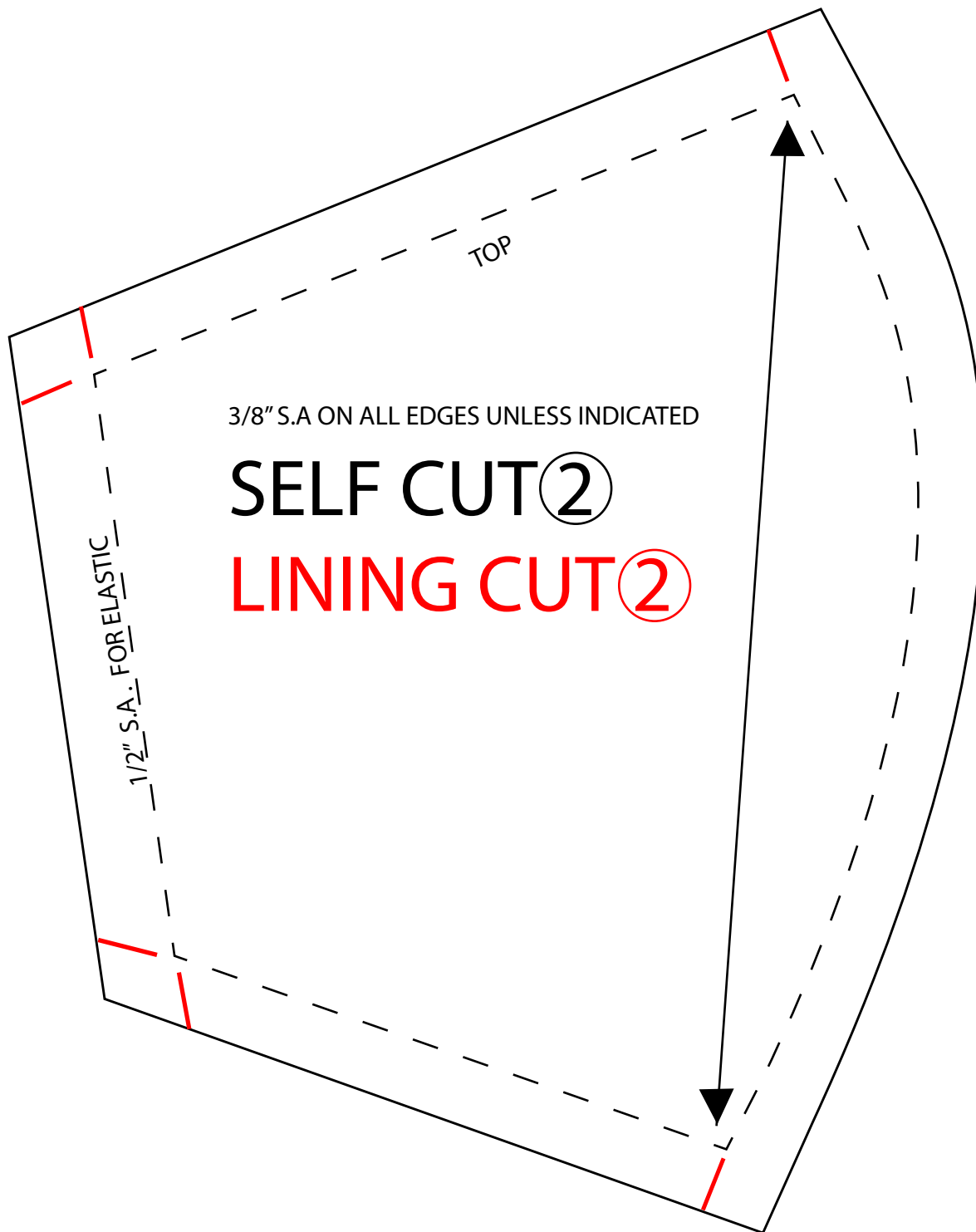

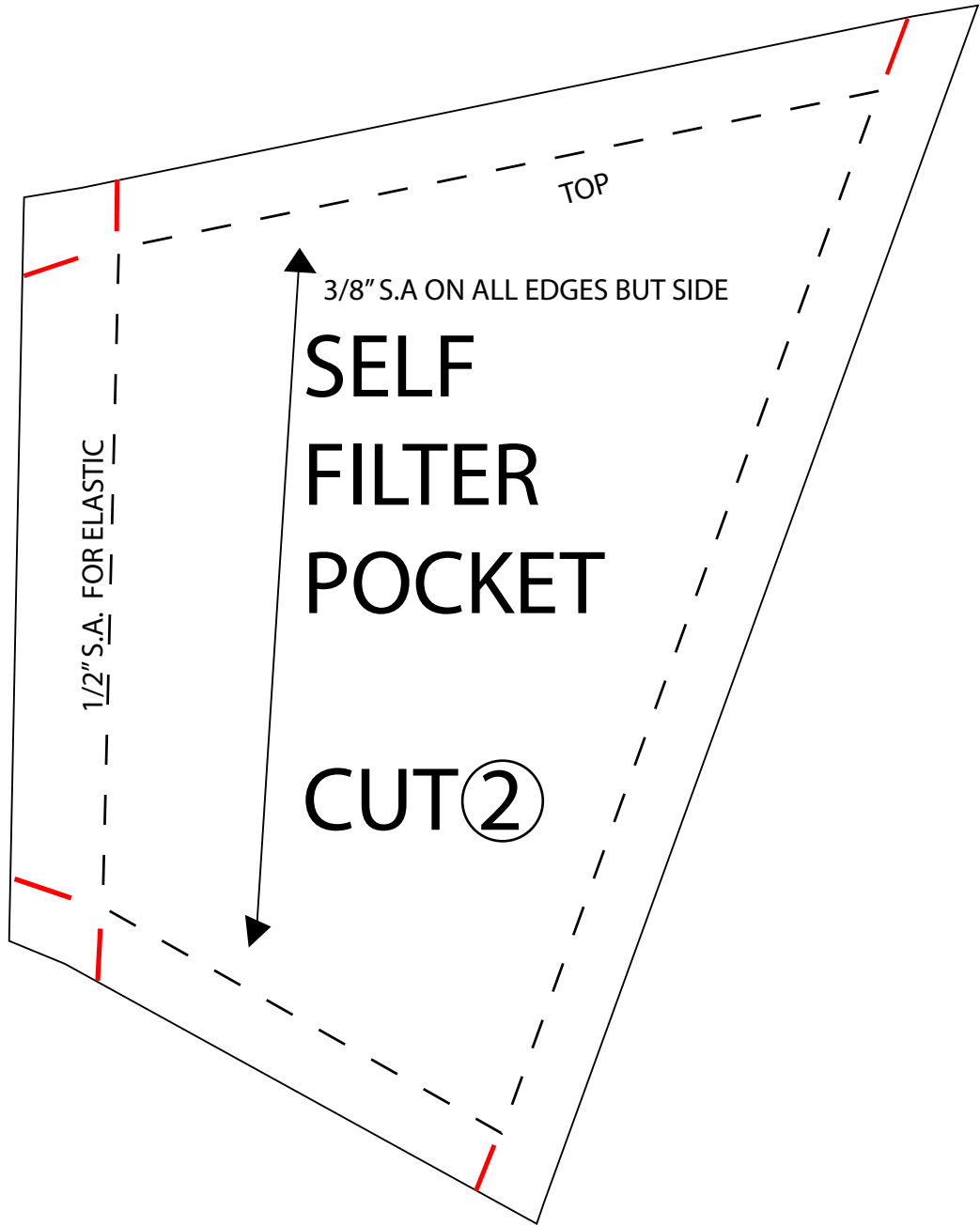
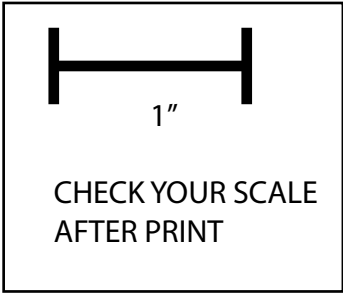


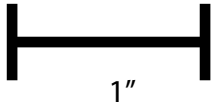


MEASUREMENTS ABOVE DO NOT INCLUDE SEAM ALLOWANCES.
