## Program tuition for domestic students

Tuition schedules and kit costs are in effect as of April 8, 2025 and apply to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada. For international student tuition and visa applications, please refer to the separate International Student Tuition Schedule. Tuition scholarships may be available from \$1000 to \$4000 for specific start dates. Please connect with an Admissions Director for further details.

## Nail Studio Diploma Program | 300 hours

Once you have been accepted into the Nail Studio Diploma Program, a non-refundable registration fee, administration fee, an assessment fee and an initial tuition payment are required in order to secure your place in the program. All tuition and kit costs are listed in Canadian dollars (CAD). For all payment options, a postdated cheque or pre-authorized credit card must be provided on the first day of class.

Following your program acceptance, the following fee payments totalling \$1,400 (exclusive of tuition) are required on the day of enrollment:

1. A non-refundable registration fee of \$250
2. An administrative fee of \$575
3. An assessment fee of \$575

### *Tuition scholarships*
